# Transport Department

Over time, risk has moved from the State Government to the Operator

- → Tenders instead of right to negotiate contracts
  - → Changes in law
- → Tougher contractual obligations

## Changes in the Law

- Passenger Transport Act 1994 (SA) and Regulations
  - > Increased emphasis on safety, compliance and driver authorisation requirements
- Occupational Health and Safety
  - > Work Health and Safety Act 2012 (SA)
  - > Work Health and Safety Act 2011 (Cth)
    - National laws regarding training and safe systems of work
    - Enforcement action for non-compliance





## Changes in the Law

- Fair Work Legislation
  - > Fair Work Act 1994 (SA)
  - > Fair Work Act 2009 (Cth)
- Environmental Legislation
  - > Environment Protection Act 1993 (SA)



- > Disability Discrimination Act 1992 (Cth)
- > Equal Opportunity Act 1984 (SA)





- New clauses being inserted into State Government Passenger Contracts
- Termination for Convenience
  - > Providing no comfort to operators or financiers
  - > Termination even if the operator is not in default
- Warranties
  - > Warrant solvency



#### Indemnities

- > You will indemnify the State, the Minister and any other office holder against any Loss
- > No reciprocal indemnity back

#### Insurances

- > Public liability insurance
- > Workers' compensation insurance
- Insurance coverage against property damage (including third party property damage)



- No exclusivity
- Contract variations
- Compliance with all laws
- Key Performance Indicator ('KPI') Penalties
- Extensions of Term
  - > Discretion of Transport Department
  - > May depend on performance of KPIs by the Operator



- Certification
  - > Certify to the department that legislative and regulatory requirements have been complied with e.g. DDA, WHS, Environmental and FWA
- Contract depot/capacity
  - May cause zoning and approval issues for operators in rural areas that are running bus services from a residential property
- Performance bonds
- Method of payment





- Viability
  - > Once you sign you have to comply.
