What is Inspire?

Inspire has been set up by The Transport Research and Educational Trust Board to be an innovative and inspirational careers foundation to support career development and promote excellence within the logistics, supply chain and transport industry in New Zealand.

Inspire is committed to helping increase and improve professional skills and expertise through education, training and development. We will do this by providing financial and mentoring assistance – and a unique resource of knowledge and expertise – for those who wish to develop their careers in this exciting sector.

Our aim is to build a community that:

- Fosters career development
- · Promotes shared learning
- Inspires professional excellence
- Supports the delivery of effective logistics and transport

Inspire is modelled on a similar UK fund, based on ideas proposed by HRH The Princess Royal, and by senior members and young professionals of the Institute. Inspire has been established by an initial donation and will continue to be funded by contributions from members, with additional support from the industry.

Who will benefit?

Inspire aims to help and support anyone who wants to develop and progress their career in the logistics, transport and supply chain industry.

People of all ages and all levels of experience will be able to benefit from Inspire funding towards:

- Scholarships, bursaries and professional education programmes
- · Expert mentoring
- Purchase of book and other training and educational materials
- · Tailored training events
- Access to a shared body of unparalleled practical knowledge

Additional funding may also be available for other opportunities.

Once the fund is established and sufficient income is generated, individuals working in the industry will be able to apply for Inspire funding and support.

Funding support may include complimentary affiliate membership of CILT NZ Inc for the period of support.

How will it work?

Inspire aims to promote professional excellence by:

- Offering support and assistance to aspiring practitioners in fulfilling their ambitions and potential
- Spreading best practice
- Sharing the collective knowledge of a network of experienced practitioners

Inspire will be managed under the umbrella of the Transport Research and Educational Trust Board, donations to the fund being maintained in a separate account from other Trust funds. All donations to the fund will be invested by the Trustees, and generally only the income from the fund, after allowing for inflation, will be distributed among the applicants chosen by the Trustees. In this way, the capital sum will be maintained for the long term.

The Awards Panel will be the Trustees.

Awards from the Fund will be made when it has generated sufficient income.


