## Transport Research and Educational Trust Awards

The CILT's Transport Research and Educational Trust is calling for applications for two personal development grants of up to \$5,000 each.

The Trust is a registered charity and makes grants to individuals and organisation involving or relating to transport and logistics.

The Trust aims are to promote, encourage and coordinate the study and advancement of the science of transport within New Zealand. Provided these aims are met, and the grants are within the educational and charitable purpose of the Trust, there is no limit on the nature of the grant, or the industry branch or discipline the applicant is involved with.

Grants are available to people of all ages and all levels of experience in logistics and transport. The grant is to help increase and improve the professional skills and expertise through education, training, and development. For example, the Trust can make grants towards the cost of mentoring, a leadership course, or other training courses or conferences.

As transport touches on many aspects of New Zealand society and economy, the Trustees encourage applications from all disciplines and individuals with an interest in this sector.

Applications are now open and will close on **Thursday 29 February 2024**. We expect to advise applicants of the decision by Thursday 21 March 2024.
