

Declaration concerning ownership of intellectual property

It is imperative that there is no infringement of any intellectual property right (IP) for the work and achievements nominated within the CILT awards. It is essential that:

- the individual or organisation being nominated declares that ownership of any IP associated with the nomination is theirs alone, or
- if the IP is shared with others, the consent of those other joint holders of the IP has been obtained and is acknowledged as part of this nomination. In categories where acknowledgement is relevant, the nomination form requires that other parties are listed and requests that this form is completed and uploaded to the on-line nomination form.

When an individual or organisation is being nominated by others without their foreknowledge, the nominator must undertake due diligence to be as certain as possible that there are no contestable IP matters involved. If there is doubt, it is better that the nomination is made with the consent of the person or organisation being nominated and that those nominated sign the declaration.

CILT NZ in making any award, will rely on the declaration concerning intellectual property and will not undertake any investigation itself or be held responsible for any breach of IP.
